

- Development of [Eden House](#) in half the space vacated by the Salvation Army on Sherbrooke at Wilson.
- Development of [Buster's Playhouse](#) in either the vacant space where Akhavan used to be on Sherbrooke at Grand or the space where PJ's Pub used to be on St. Jacques.
- Development of the [NuVoWay LifeStyle Centre NDG](#), transforming the Monkland Tennis Club as well as 1/2 the northernmost LCC field.
- Development of [Animal Art Gallery](#) (mortar and brick or potentially virtual) in half the space vacated by the Salvation Army on Sherbrooke at Wilson as a means to generate funds to offset costs of all endeavours related to transforming NDG into a cutting edge community in all areas of animal rights/welfare.
